**PRESS RELEASE**

Warren County Sheriff Kevin Harrison reports the arrest of a 29 year old man and woman both from Marthasville Missouri on July 15, 2011 on drug related charges and for endangering the welfare of children living in the residence. The suspects were identified as:



Samuel J. Skiff, W, M, 29 Years Old  
18000 Block Hwy N, Marthasville Missouri  
Manufacturing Controlled Substance  
Possession of Controlled Substance  
Endangering Welfare of Child  
Bond \$35,000.00 Cash or Surety



Juanita J. Dusenberg, W, F, 29 Years Old  
18000 Block Hwy N, Marthasville Missouri  
Possession of Controlled Substance  
Endangering Welfare of Child  
Bond \$20,000.00 Cash

The charges originated from a contact at the residence on Highway N in the Holstein area by WCSD Patrol Corporal Andy Huston who was trying to arrest Skiff on a fugitive warrant. Skiff attempted to flee from Huston by running out the back door. While Huston was at the residence he located items commonly used in the clandestine manufacturing of methamphetamines. Huston contacted WCSD Detective Jeff Doerr to assist in the investigation. A search warrant was obtained and executed on the residence. Items seized included pill binders, lithium battery strips, cold medicine, Coleman fuel, acetone, coffee filters, drug paraphernalia, substances believed to be marijuana, and substances believed to be methamphetamines. Due to two minor children living in the residence that contained the meth lab, and the fact the items were within the reach of the children, both Skiff and Dusenberg were charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child.
