Warren County Sheriff Kevin Harrison reports the arrest of six persons in connection with a clandestine methamphetamine laboratory being operated in a residence located at 17525 North Service Road in Wright City Missouri. Around 10:00pm on the evening of Wednesday January 6, 2010 detectives from the Warren County Sheriff's Department were investigating allegations of drug activity and chemical odors coming from the residence. Upon arrival to the location they made contact with two male subjects outside the residence in a shed. One of the subjects attempted to flee the area on foot, but was apprehended by the deputies.
